

## **Charging, Remissions and Subsidy Policy**

Our priority is to ensure that all children, young people, and other members of the community, regardless of background, can access high-quality, diverse music education and are encouraged to develop high aspirations for their musical engagement. *Our Charging, Remissions and Subsidy Policy* aims to ensure this is the case. We work flexibly with funding/funders to help support as many families and young people as possible.

## **Bexley Music (Evening and Saturday Centre, Belmont Academy)**

- The charging structure for instrumental lessons and ensembles is subsidised by Bexley Music. The fees passed onto parents do not represent the total cost to Bexley Music
- Discounts are available for ensemble membership for:
  - More than one member of a family
  - Membership of more than one ensemble
  - Over 65s
- Bespoke instalment/ payment plans are offered for all lessons and music tour payments
- Holiday courses and clubs are heavily subsidised or free

#### Schools' Provision

We encourage and support schools to use their resources, including pupil premium and other available funding, to support those families in need who want to access music education opportunities beyond the curriculum.

- Bexley Music, with support from Arts Council England, offers the opportunity for all schools to take advantage of subsidised First Access lessons (Whole Class Ensemble Tuition) – the equivalent of a fully funded term of lessons, including a free class set of instruments. We work with schools to ensure all whole class activity is free to all participants.
- Bexley Music holiday courses and clubs are open to all school pupils at the subsidised rate or free of charge.
- All Music Hub performance opportunities are free of charge to participating schools. This includes the annual Bexley Festival of Music (Fairfield Halls/Royal Festival Halls) and all Music Hub performances in the local area. No contribution is sought for rental charges.
- Music CPD is offered to all schools at a subsidised rate.
- The Bexley Music Hub partnership with London Symphony Orchestra (LSO) offers subsidised places to school staff on the LSO Teacher Training programme (Music in the Classroom)

- Free initial consultations are offered by the Head and Deputy of Bexley Music. Any followup is subsidised.
- Annual instrumental demonstrations involving at least 4 Bexley Music tutors are offered free of charge.
- Bespoke projects between Bexley Music Hub and schools are match-funded or subsidised by Bexley Music.

### **Additional Funding**

- London Music Fund (LMF): Our partnership with the LMF provides four years of funding to students identified as meeting the criteria. There are 1-2 places available for Bexley students per year.
- Rotary Club: Through its partnership with the Bexley Music Hub, the local organisation
  offers funding for music tours, youth music mentoring opportunities, master classes, etc.
  Through the Rotary Club of Sidcup Educational Trust (RoSET), students can apply
  independently of Bexley Music for funding to 'pursue educational and character-forming
  projects'.
- The Friends of Bexley Music exists to raise funds for Bexley Music, some of which are ringfenced for pupil bursaries for those experiencing financial barriers to pursuing their music education.
- Bexley Music Bursary Awards: This is a fund financed by grants, awards and fundraising to
  ensure that the musical opportunities provided by Bexley Music Hub are accessible to all.
